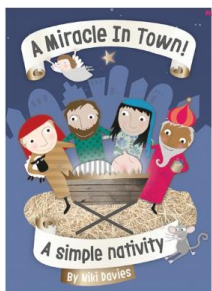
FILM NIGHTS
