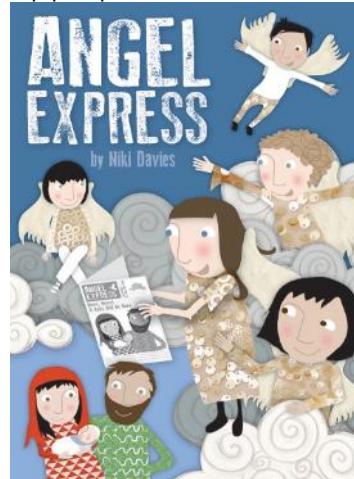
All funds raised will go towards supporting our school activities and resources. Thank you for your enthusiasm and support — let's see how many goals our young players can score! 🏆
