to do if they ever found themselves in fire danger at home. They also found out the importance of a fire alarm and a fire plan.



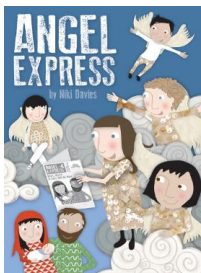
### CHRISTMAS RECITAL
