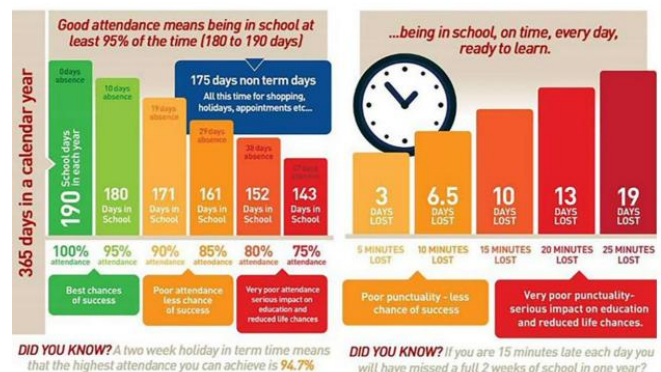

Some of 'Learning Themes' for the Spring Term 1 are:

Class1 (Nursery/ EYFS): Healthy Eating, where food comes from, looking at different fruit and vegetables. Making sandwiches and fruit kebabs. Reading Handa's Surprise and The Enormous Turnip.
