

## Where is the Knight?

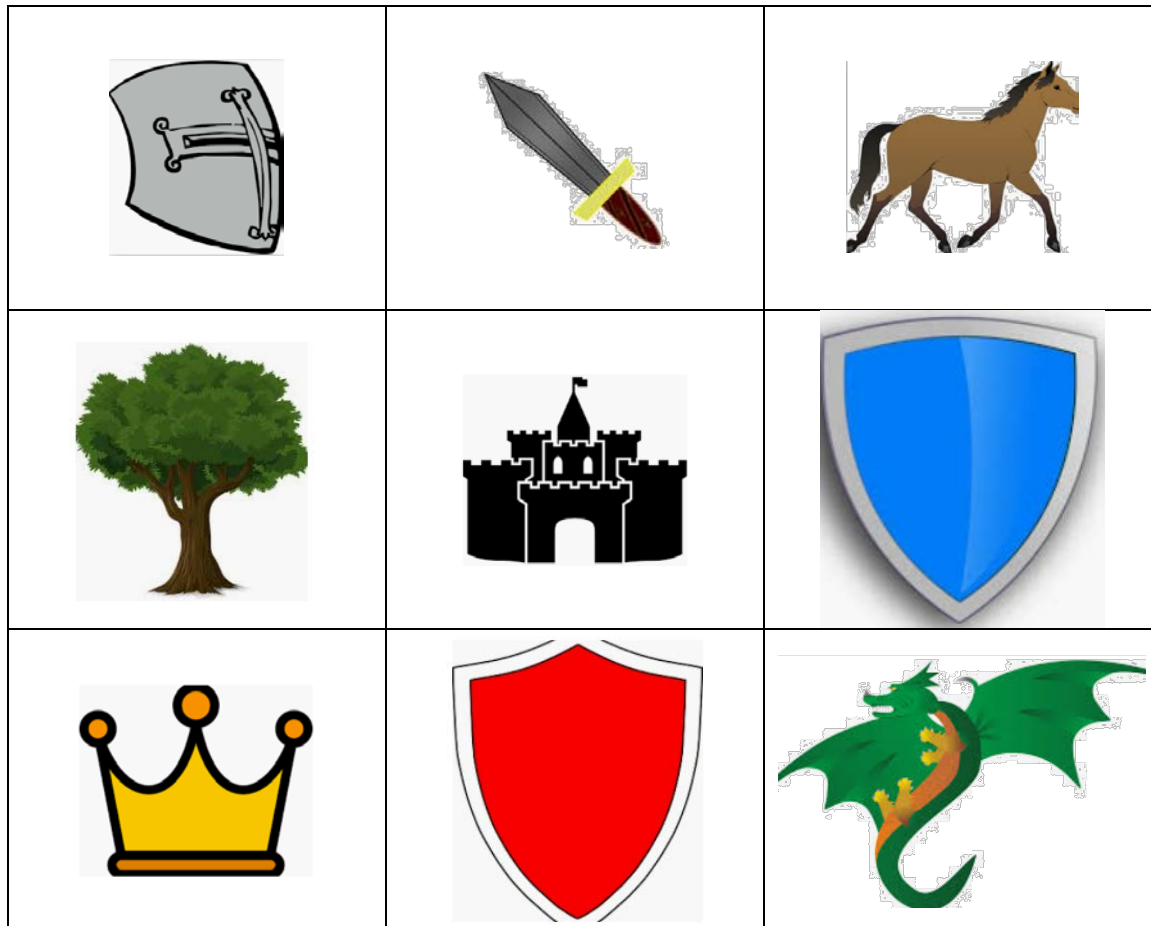
We use lots of different words to describe something's position.

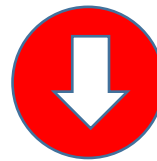

Forwards	Backwards
