

### Maths

The children will study the following areas in depth:  
Place Value - up to 7 digit numbers  
Comparing numbers  
Written addition and subtraction methods.

### DT

The children will work with different fabrics and will use different techniques to design, make and evaluate their own bag made from upcycled/recycled products, They will also learn the skill of weaving linking to their History topic.

### English

In English we will be looking at Legends and linking this to our History Topic. We will be using the novels Beowulf, Anglo-Saxon Boy and Viking Boy which are great stimuli for debates, discussions and cross curricular writing.

### MFL

This half term, the children will look at vocabulary and phrases they would expect to use in a French School.

### Music

The children will follow the unit 'Recorder World' with Mrs Blackledge.

### History

The children will focus on the topic of Anglo-Saxons. They will place certain events on a timeline and will look at invasions, settlements, daily life, homes and religion. They will also study Beowulf and Sutton Hoo and the different Kingdoms around this time. This topic will link with their DT and English units.
